What's a QR code, anyway?



**A QR code
(an initialism for quick response code)
is essentially a visual shortcut, that
allows an optical reader system
(like your phone) to process and
execute a specific command.**

**In our use, it's going to be
pointing a web browser to a specific URL
(web address).**

**Like your MK website, or maybe a specific
document you have online somewhere.**

The creation of such a complex thing is made easy by using any number of online QR code generators.

Most are free but some have a “Pro” option if you were going to be producing hundreds and wanted to track them using that site’s database analysis tools.

FLOWCODE.com

Offers 3 Free codes that Never expire and can be tracked so you can see how many people are using it.

Best of all, it's easy to use.

You will need to create an account, and log in.

Don't go too small though.

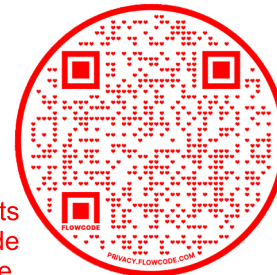

When users scan it, a small link pops up, they'll click that, and the code will open a browser to display your web site.

All they need to do is use the camera on their smartphone and point it at the code. There is no special app they need!

This works great in signs that you might have at a public event, a card that you hand out, basically anywhere, where you want to quickly share your web site address without them (or you) needing to type it in or memorize it.
